Ronan Ó Fathaigh is a Senior Researcher at the Institute for Information Law, Faculty of Law, University of Amsterdam. His research focuses on freedom of expression, media freedom, and privacy. Ronan is a member of the Council of Europe's Committee of Experts on the Integrity of Online Information (MSI-INF); a member of the European Commission's Expert group against SLAPPs (Strategic Lawsuits Against Public Participation), and a member of the Columbia Global Freedom of Expression initiative at Columbia University. Ronan has published his work in numerous international academic journals, including *European Human Rights Law Review*, *Communications Law*, *Journal of Media Law*, *European Data Protection Law Review*, *Internet Policy Review*, and *International Journal of Law and Information Technology*, and is a regular contributor to the *Strasbourg Observers* human rights blog, commenting on current freedom of expression issues. Ronan has a PhD in law from the Human Rights Centre at Ghent University, and is a former Legal Researcher with the Irish public broadcaster (RTÉ), and former visiting Research Fellow at Columbia University, New York City.
